## 1.A. MEDIA

Policy Reference: EL-1.8

The Board recognizes that some media that have restricted or "R" rating programs may have a designated classification requiring parental approval and may yet be appropriate for some educational programs. Before using the media in a classroom, teachers must:

- a) view the material;
- b) be conscientious of the community standards and the appropriateness of such material for instructional purposes;
- c) notify the principal and Superintendent/CEO that material of this nature will be used;
- d) receive a permission slip from each student's parent(s)/guardian(s), before the student views the material;
- e) ensure that the material falls within proper licensing agreements;
- f) make the material available for parent viewing (copy available at school).

Only those films for which Lakeshore School Division has public performance rights through its licensee may be shown in the schools. Location license covers educational classroom exhibition only, exhibition for entertainment purposes is prohibited. No admission may be charged to attend the screening. Each school is to forward a reporting form, stating film watched, date, producer, monthly to the Office Assistant. Contact the Office Assistant for updates on licensee and represented producers.
