**1.B. ILLICIT DRUGS, CANNABIS AND ALCOHOL**

**Policy Reference: EL-1.1**

Illicit drugs and/or drug paraphernalia, alcohol and cannabis are not permitted in Lakeshore School Division schools or on school property. For the purposes of this procedure, drugs other than over the counter or prescription drugs, used under the specific conditions and intended medical purpose as indicated on the label or by the prescription, are defined as illicit drugs.

It is recognized that a student must not be under the influence or impaired by illicit drugs, alcohol or cannabis while in an educational setting or school sanctioned outing.

Where a student uses medical cannabis, they must disclose, prior to use, their requirement for use and are required to provide a copy of their medical license to use cannabis to Lakeshore School Division and abide by direction for accommodation that is provided by the Division.

With the requisite accommodations, the medical documentation must address safety and the ability to fulfill educational requirements and must provide information on the strength and dosage of the prescription and whether or not an alternate to smoking may be utilized (foods, oils, creams, etc.).
